

2019- 2020 RA DELEGATE ELECTIONS TIMELINES

- 12/1/19 Service Center Councils may begin accepting State Delegate Declaration of Candidacy Forms.
- 1/31/20 *Deadline for Service Center Council Chairs to receive State Delegate Declaration of Candidacy forms.
- 2/24/20-
3/18/20 Election Procedures - **All ballots Approved by Election Chair prior to Mailing**
- *Chapters conduct election for local and state delegates.
 - *Chapters send State delegate election voted-ballots, signature sheets/rosters, and completed signature and ballot verification sheet to **Santa Maria RRC. By 5:00 pm on 3/20/20**
 - *Service Center Council shall place all State delegate election ballots in one stack for counting and tally the ballots. Send names on final teller's report to CTA Elections and Credentials Committee.
- 3/24/20
to
3/25/20 **Service Center Election Committee Counts Ballot**
- Deadline for filing a challenge to the election with the CTA President is within four **(4)** calendar days after the ballots are counted, including any run-offs if necessary.**
- 4/13/20 Delegates who have been elected to both local and state delegate positions, must notify the Service Center Council of the position selected. (Delegates may not hold both positions.)
- 4/20/20 Service Center Council chairperson must notify CTA of names of successor state delegates if an elected state delegate chooses to go as a local delegate.
- 6/1/20 Deadline for filing an appeal of the CTA Board of Directors decision on a challenge with the NEA Credentials Committee regarding alleged violations of election requirements.

IT IS MANDATORY THAT THE TIMELINES BE FOLLOWED.
